British Normandy Memorial Waymarkers

The Memorial will record the names of the approximately 21,000 British personnel who lost their lives in the landings and the campaign which followed. Liam O'Connor Architect and the British Normandy Trust Client.

Charles Bergen Studios is designing five-flag sized waterjet cut bronze waymarking signs that will direct visitors to the five invasion beaches—Utah, Omaha, Gold, Juno, and Sword Beach. The sculptural works will be part artifact, part signage, and part art. With a bronze patina to match the three figurative sculptures at the Memorial itself these signs both direct visitors to the five invasion beaches as well as tell the story of what happened on each beach on D-Day.
